The Rise of a Visionary Fashion Designer



One such name is Exquisite Designs by Phumzile, a proudly Motswana fashion brand birthed out of creativity, resilience, and a deep love for storytelling through fabric. At the heart of this remarkable journey is Siphumuzile Akolang, the founder and sole owner, whose vision was always more than just creating beautiful garments. Her mission has always been clear, to make wearable poetry.

When she first set foot in fashion school, she didn't know that her journey would take her from long unpaid hours to invitations from global runways. But in every stitch she sews and every silhouette she sculpts, there's a story of determination, passion, and transformation. This is the story of a designer who turned dreams into designs, and designs into a thriving brand.

After completing fashion school in 2014, Siphumuzile's dedication to dress design was undeniable. So much so that one of her teachers went the extra mile, connecting her with a designer friend who would soon become a pivotal figure in her early career. By January 2015, she was offered a job, with one generous condition: she could work on her own pieces after hours, as long as they didn't interfere with her day job.

And so, she began, juggling demanding work by day and fulfilling her own client orders by night. "I'd take orders and sew overnight," she recalls. "That's how the seed was planted." By May 2015, that seed had taken root, and her brand was officially registered.

But the glamour was not immediate. From 2015 to 2017, she endured a stagnant wage, lower than even the national minimum, with no sign of improvement. "When I wasn't paid on the 10th, I snapped," she admits. "I told him I couldn't continue working under those conditions." That decisive moment pushed her to go full-time with her brand, a bold leap into uncertain waters, fueled only by grit and vision.

Securing her own office space was a major milestone, especially in a mall filled with fabric shops, a fitting home for a budding designer. While progress initially felt slow, she later realized that sharing the space with another designer offering similar services may have impacted the pace. Still, her artistry refused to go unnoticed.

What sets Exquisite Designs by Phumzile apart is more than just the cut of a dress or the detail in a hem, it's the meaning sewn into every piece. Her creations are



exquisite garments that fuse poetic imagery with wearable art. "It's a trend that exists between fashion, literature, and visual arts," she explains. "It allows the client to wear and portray their own statement."

Each design begins with a conversation. "I do custom work, so we sit down and discuss the client's personal style and vision before I even begin constructing the garment," she says. For her, fashion is not just about what you see, it's what you feel. "When designing, we step into a space where the interface is no longer just visual. It becomes something that merges with the client's body and the occasion itself."

Texture, finishing, the value of a good stitch, these details matter to her. They're the signature of a designer who doesn't just dress people, but transforms them.

Her work has caught the attention of industry professionals far beyond Botswana. She's been invited to show in New York, Paris, and Nigeria, although financial constraints have kept her from accepting those offers. Yet, each invitation is a nod to the power of her artistry and the uniqueness of her brand. A major turning point came when she joined the Mr Price Group's fashion mentorship program. It wasn't just an internship, it was an awakening. "It significantly boosted my profile," she says. "The mentorship gave me insights into innovation, helped me reassess my brand, and offered a clearer direction for the future."

That future is already taking shape. She's now focused on launching a ready-to-wear core collection for each season, expanding her market share by reaching new customer segments, and setting specific sales targets for each product line. But more than numbers, it's about alignment, making sure every achievement moves in harmony with her vision.

The Journey Between Heartbreak and Hope: Gaona Dintwe's I-Rise foundation.

Motherhood is often spoken about as though it follows a predictable path. For some women, it does. For others, it becomes a journey marked by waiting, uncertainty, hope, heartbreak, and resilience.

For years, Gaona Dintwe carried questions about her own reproductive health. Severe menstrual pain and heavy bleeding had become a normal part of life from a young age. Like many women, she was told little about what those symptoms could mean and spent years searching for answers.

It was only at the age of 28, during surgery initially intended to remove fibroids, that doctors discovered severe endometriosis and a frozen pelvis – a condition where organs become bound together by scar

tissue. Along with the diagnosis came words that would change the course of her life: she might struggle to conceive.

At the time, those words sounded like a delay rather than a possibility that motherhood could become a long and uncertain journey.

What followed were years of navigating infertility, medical interventions, hope and disappointment. Twelve years after her diagnosis, Dintwe finally fell pregnant. What felt like an answered prayer, however, ended in a devastating second-trimester pregnancy loss.

For many women, infertility is not simply about the inability to conceive. It is also about loss, grief, identity, relationships,

faith, finances and the emotional burden of carrying expectations that society places on women.

It is this reality that inspired Dintwe to establish the I-RISE Foundation, officially launched this week to provide support for individuals and couples navigating infertility and reproductive health challenges.

“Not because I had all the answers,” she told attendees, “but because I knew what it felt like to carry the questions.”

The foundation seeks to bridge the gap between isolation and support through psychosocial assistance, awareness and educational campaigns, community building and advocacy for individuals and couples

navigating fertility and reproductive health challenges. The foundation also recognises that healing, dignity and wellbeing remains important regardless of reproductive outcomes.

Too often, women facing fertility challenges are subjected to intrusive questions, unsolicited advice and misplaced blame. From suggestions to “just relax” to recommendations for traditional remedies or assumptions that prayer alone will solve the problem, many find themselves carrying a burden that extends far beyond medical diagnosis.

Yet infertility affects both women and men, a fact that is often overlooked in conversations around reproductive health.

One of the most moving moments during the launch came through anonymous testimonies shared by individuals who had experienced infertility firsthand.

A mother of two spoke about enduring multiple IVF cycles before finally seeing two lines on a pregnancy test after years of heartbreak.

“When I finally held my baby boy, everything changed,” she shared. “He did not just make me a mother. He healed a part of me that had been hurting for years.”

A year later, another IVF cycle brought her a daughter.

Today, she describes her children as daily reminders that hope is worth holding onto.

Her story resonated deeply with many in attendance because it reflected what so many families experience quietly behind closed doors, the determination to keep believing even when the road feels impossible.

Beyond raising awareness, the I-RISE Foundation hopes to create a safe community where people can share their experiences without shame and explore conversations around alternative paths to parenthood, including fostering, adoption and other family-building options.

At its heart, the foundation is about ensuring that people facing infertility do not feel invisible.

For women whose journeys to motherhood have been shaped by loss, waiting and unanswered questions, that message may be exactly what they need to hear: that their stories matter, their experiences are valid, and they do not have to walk the journey alone.

Everything you'll need for the best chicken bacon pasta salad

This healthy chicken bacon pasta salad is filled with flavor, colors and textures that make it absolutely irresistible. Here's everything you'll need to make it:

- Chicken: grilled chicken adds delicious flavor and protein to this pasta salad.

- Bacon: salty, savory bacon is the star of the show in this pasta salad. I have instructions for cooking bacon on the stovetop in this recipe, but you can easily cook it in your oven with this tutorial.

Add your favorite type of corn

Feel free to add raw corn off the cobb to the salad for ease, otherwise, you can saute or grill it! I have the best method for grilling corn here.

Customize your chicken bacon pasta salad

Looking to mix up some of the ingredients?

Here's what I can recommend:

- Make it gluten free. Simply use your favorite gluten free pasta shape.
- Go vegetarian. Feel free to swap the chicken and bacon for a can of chickpeas!
- Add a boost of greens. Chopped romaine would be delicious for a BLT vibe, and arugula would add a wonderful zippiness.
- Cheese it up. This chicken bacon pasta salad would also be delicious with a sprinkle of freshly grated parmesan cheese, cheddar cheese, or even feta crumbles!

Make it ahead of time

This chicken bacon pasta salad will stay fresh in an airtight container in the fridge for about 3-4 days, so feel free to prep it the night before a picnic or BBQ, or prep it for your weekday lunches. I would recommend adding the avocado when you're ready to serve so that it stays fresh.

Ingredients

- For the pasta salad:
- 2 grilled chicken breasts, cubed/diced (or sub 1 ½-2 cups shredded chicken)
- 8 ounces bacon
- 8 ounces cavatappi or bowtie pasta (or pasta of choice!)
- 1 pint cherry tomatoes, halved (I love using heirloom cherry tomatoes for color variety!)
- 1 ½ cups corn, grilled, raw or sauteed
- ¼ cup thinly sliced red onion (or sub diced green onion)
- 1 slightly ripe avocado, diced
- For the greek yogurt ranch:
- ¼ cup plain greek yogurt
- ½ cup store bought ranch dressing

Instructions

- Make sure you have your grilled or cooked chicken done ahead of time, or feel free to grill it first. This is a great recipe for using leftover chicken! Check out our post on how to make the best chicken breasts here. You can either dice it into ½ inch cubes or feel free to shred it. I prefer diced for this recipe, but it's up to you and what you have on hand.
- Next, cook your bacon: add bacon to a large skillet or pan and place over medium heat, cook bacon on both sides until crispy and golden brown. If the pan starts to smoke at any point, simply lower the heat. I always cook my bacon on medium-low heat. Once bacon is done, blot with a paper towel to absorb excess grease, then chop into bite-sized pieces and set aside.
- While your bacon cooks, you can cook your pasta until al dente, drain and then place in a large bowl.
- Mix together your greek yogurt ranch by combining greek yogurt and ranch dressing until smooth and creamy. Pour over the pasta and stir until well combined. Next add the chicken, chopped bacon, corn, halved cherry tomatoes, sliced red onion and avocado. Gently toss again, then taste and adjust seasonings as necessary, adding more salt and pepper or extra ranch dressing, if you'd like. Serves 6, or 4 as a larger meal. Garnish with extra corn, tomatoes, red onion, avocado and bacon.

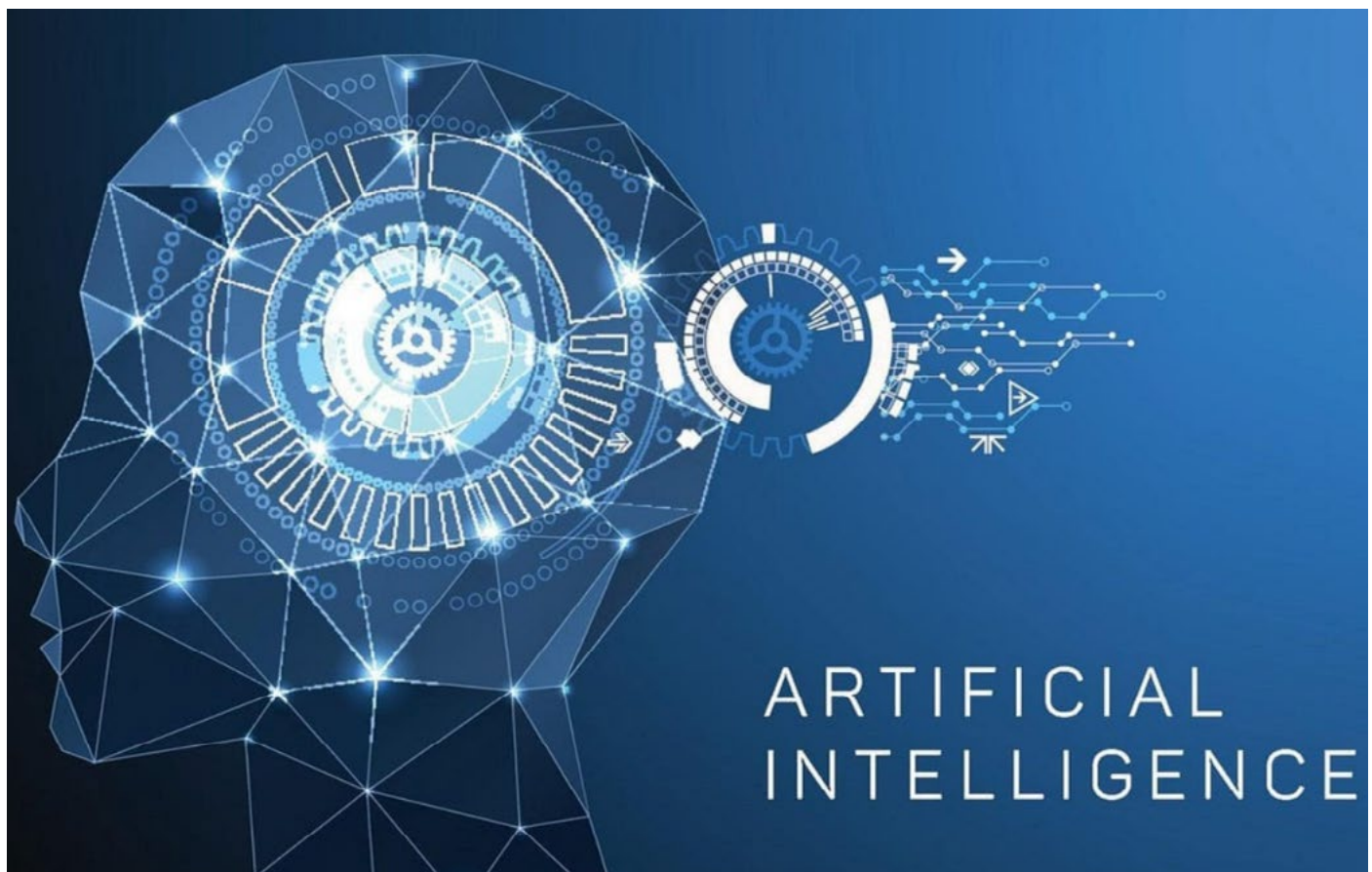

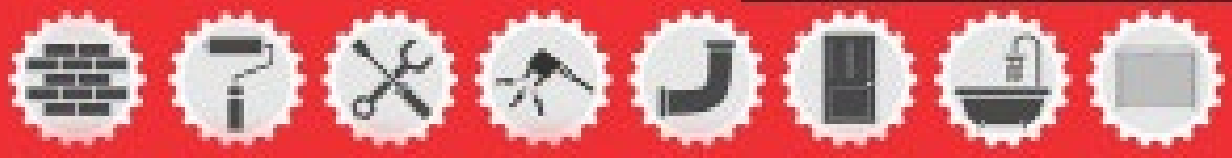
